Comprehensive Arts & Science (CAS) Blended – 1 Year

Comprehensive Arts & Science is designed for high school and Adult Basic Education graduates who would like to improve their general employability skills or who are lacking either the academic courses or required grades to meet the entrance requirements of the college or university program they would like to enter. Here at St. Anthony Campus, we are offering the CAS program as a multi-site blended program whereby students may attend class on-campus, linked-in via video with an instructor live in-class from another site.



Construction/Industrial Electrician – 9 Month

The Construction/Industrial Electrician program will provide the practical and theoretical knowledge necessary for an excellent start in this compulsory Red Seal Apprenticeship trade. The training includes, but is not limited to, acquiring skills to secure employment in residential, commercial and industrial sectors.



Heavy Equipment Operator – 9 Month

This program provides training in safe and effective operation of heavy-duty earth moving operations of heavy equipment and performing preventative maintenance. Students develop the skills necessary to become proficient in the use of various pieces of heavy equipment. The theory component is completed at St. Anthony Campus while the fieldwork component takes place at Bay St. George Campus.



Office Administration (Certificate) Blended – 1 Year

Graduates from the certificate program will acquire knowledge and office skills for entry level employment in the office of today. Courses are offered through a blended model whereby some are offered on-campus and others are offered online.

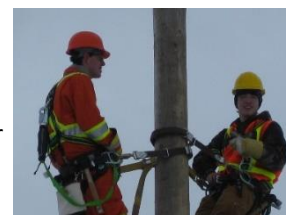


Office Administration (Executive) Blended – 2 Year

This two-year diploma program is designed to enable students to acquire the Skills and knowledge needed to work as administrative assistants in today's modern office. Major components of the program include document production, transcription and office management. Related courses include communications, computerized accounting, computer applications and organizational behaviour. Courses are offered through a blended model whereby some are offered on-campus and others are offered online.

Powerline Technician (Operating) – 9 Month

For some people, working outdoors beats everything else. Powerline technicians work on underground power lines as well as building and repairing overhead lines. First, they have to erect wood, steel or concrete poles as well as towers and guy wires. Then come the power lines, cables, insulators, transformers and other equipment.
